Winery Profile

Azienda Agricola Moletto is a family-owned estate in the province of Treviso (Veneto). Commendatore Mario Stival and his sons Mauro and Giovanni share administrative responsibilities and oversee all phases of the wineries operation. Mario and his sons are all oenologists and graduates of the viticultural school in Conegliano.

Moletto wines are made from estate grown grapes from the Piave and Lison-Pramaggiore DOC growing district. The white wines are light and crisp offering exceptional value, the red wines are even more impressive. The proven ability of the Moletto estate to produce quality wine in the traditional manner has enabled the Stival family to hand down wines of superior quality and elegance from father to son for three generations.

Moletto Merlot

The intensity of varietal characters, color and extracts obtained from the Merlot grapes grown on the estate makes a vibrant and robust Merlot. After aging, the wine becomes rounded and soft. This wine is good upon release but should improve up to 3 years of age.

Moletto Pinot Grigio

This straw-yellow colored wine has set the standard for the line for the past two decades. It is a perfectly balanced crisp and fruity white wine.

You will find it difficult to find a better Pinot Grigio although you will find many that are more expensive.

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Moletto Colmello Rosso



ABV 13%

Colmello Rosso is made mainly from selected-Merlot, and Franconia grapes combined with Malbec and Cabernet Franc and Raboso grapes varying in proportion from year to year.

This wine is then aged in French oak barrels to add complexity and flavor. The wine is an intense ruby red color, full bodied, very big and supple. It will continue to improve with age. Winemaker Giovanni has made his “capo lavoro”- his “Masterpiece”.

Moletto Cabernet Sauvignon Select



ABV 14.5%

It is created from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes grown in the Lison Pramaggiore zone of the winery's vineyards. It has a wonderful deep, intense red hue which blossoms into a heady, rich bouquet with the spiciness of oak, the aroma of vanilla and the pungent scent of leather. On tasting, one is enveloped in its full, harmonious flavor with warm cherry and plum overtones and velvety touch of tannin. It is a wine for connoisseurs who are sure to appreciate this new “offspring” of the Moletto winery.
